



Academic Results 2020/21

Due to the pandemic, the DfE have again not published results for this academic year so the national percentages have been taken from the 2018/19 national data.

Early Years (Nursery to end of Reception Class)

Percentage of children reaching the agreed 'Good Level of Development' standard are:
2021: **Mylnhurst 92%** (Nationally 71.8% in 2019)

Key Stage 1 (Preps 1&2)

Due to the pandemic, the phonics screening test was not taken this academic year

End of Key Stage 2 (Prep 6)

Due to the pandemic, Prep 6 children did not take the National Curriculum Tests as in previous years. Our results are based on teacher assessment and results from past papers.

The percentage of children meeting or exceeding the end of Key Stage Two expectations are:

Reading: **Mylnhurst 95%** (Nationally 73% in 2019)

Grammar, Punctuation & Spelling: **Mylnhurst 100%** (Nationally 78% in 2019)

Mathematics: **Mylnhurst 90%** (Nationally 79% in 2019)
